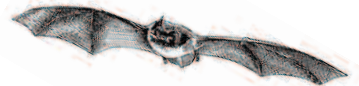

Simple Surveys

The easiest way to be involved is to watch out for bats when you happen to be out at night. If you see bats then add your record(s) to the Perth and Kinross Council 'bat page' www.pkc.gov.uk/countryside or fill up the bat record card attached.

Bat Detector Surveys

These surveys are suitable for the slightly more adventurous and those who;

- Live within or have transport into the city.
- Can spare around 10 hours over May – September, to attend training meetings and carry out surveys.
- Feel confident about being out as late as 11pm.
- Are able to cover a 1-2km route at dusk.

Please note volunteers will be encouraged to carry out surveys in pairs or small groups.

The PCBP is an exciting opportunity to get involved in bat surveys over summer 2009. Surveys range from **Simple Surveys** to **Bat Detector Surveys**. No bat knowledge is needed to start with, free training will be given and bat detectors will be loaned to volunteers.
