

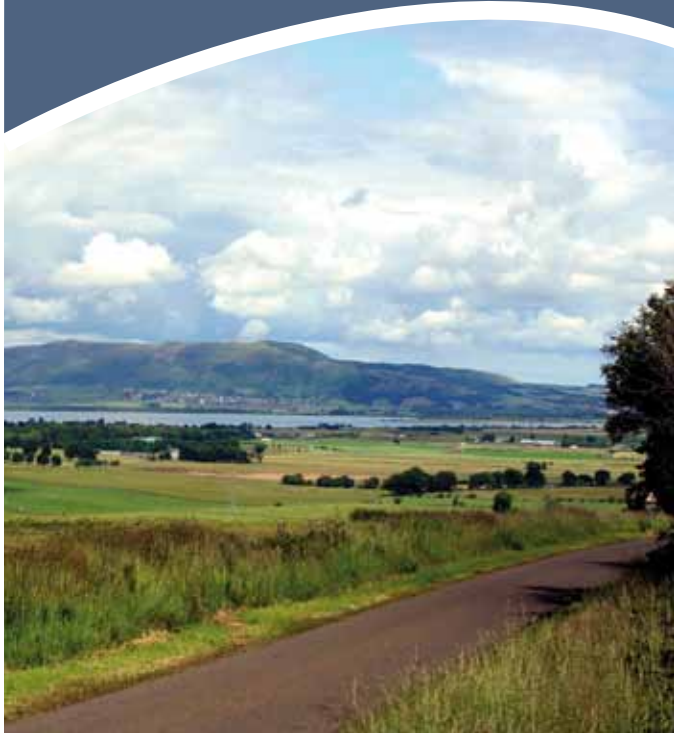
Loch Leven and the Heritage Trail

Loch Leven is a sparkling jewel surrounded by rolling hills and fertile farmland. This picturesque loch is a National Nature Reserve with a remarkable range of wildlife, including tens of thousands of breeding and wintering birds.

The Loch Leven Heritage Trail takes you to some of the most attractive parts of the loch, so you can experience its remarkable history, nature and beauty at first hand.

The Heritage Trail is a traffic free path linking Kinross with Vane Farm. It is well signposted so you won't get lost and nearby cafes can provide refreshments.

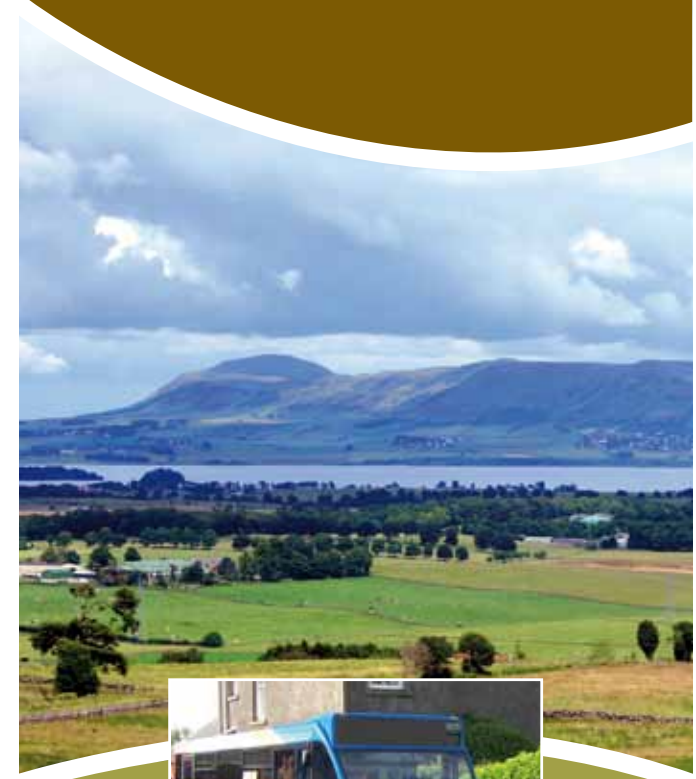

LOCH LEVEN HERITAGE TRAIL

Take the Bus for a Walk...

Service 203 is a 'round the loch' bus service which is funded by Perth & Kinross Council in response to public requests and the need to provide a public transport link between various points along the Loch Leven Heritage Trail.

This service runs every Sunday (apart from Sunday, 26 December 2010). The bus is operated by Stagecoach Fife and goes round Loch Leven, stopping at Kinross, Milnathort, Burleigh Sands, Loch Leven's Larder, Kinnesswood, Scotlandwell, Lochend Farm Shop & Café, Findatie Coffee Shop, Vane Farm, Gairneybridge and Gairneybank.

The bus, which is wheelchair accessible, operates both anti-clockwise and clockwise loops around the loch.

As well as single tickets, Sunday stroller tickets are available costing £1.50 for adults, 75p for children and £3.00 for families. These tickets allow unlimited travel for the day and so you can hop on and off the bus as many times as you want. National entitlement cards are also valid on this service.

Alternatively, if you would like to use local bus services to visit Loch Leven Heritage Trail between Monday and Saturday, Stagecoach Fife Service 201 serves most of the Heritage Trail apart from Burleigh Sands, Lochend Farm Shop & Café, Findatie Coffee Shop and Vane Farm. Stagecoach Fife Service 204 provides a limited link to Vane Farm from Kinross via Gairneybridge on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
