## 716. APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

There was submitted a report by the Executive Director (Corporate Services) (06/768) on applications received for financial assistance.

### **Resolved:**

#### **(a) Aberfeldy Parish Church**

Aberfeldy Parish Church be awarded a grant of £150 towards the cost of winding the local clock, on Taybridge Road, for the year 2006.

#### **(b) Breadalbane Community Garden**

Aberfeldy Community Garden Committee be awarded a grant of £5,000 to cover the cost of fencing, plants, trees/shrubs, poly tunnel and a shed.
