1. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no Declarations of Interest made in terms of the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

2. SHARED HEADSHIP PILOT

There was submitted a report by the Executive Director (Education and Children's Services) (08/479) on the schools to be involved in the Shared Headship Pilot commencing October 2008 and the appointment procedure for Principal Teachers for the identified schools.

Resolved:

- (i) The schools to be involved in the two different pilots to commence in October 2008, be noted as
 - (a) two schools under one Head Teacher: (1) Kinloch Rannoch and Struan Primaries and (2) Blair Atholl and Logierait Primaries.
 - (b) one school with a job-share Headship: Comrie Primary
- (ii) It be noted that the job sizing and recruitment of Principal Teacher posts in each school with a shared Head Teacher would commence immediately.
- (iii) An evaluation be undertaken from the commencement of the pilots with an initial review in April 2009.

3. RESPONSE TO THE SCOTTISH GOVERNMENT CONSULTATION PAPER – SAFEGUARDING OUR RURAL SCHOOLS AND IMPROVING SCHOOL CONSULTATION PROCEDURES
