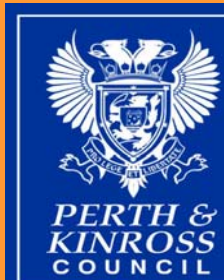
What is Placecheck?

Priorities Identified on the 29th August 2009

These were the priorities for improvements to public space areas identified by the Milnathort community.

Issues that appeared in more than one zone have been grouped together.

Zone 1 Priorities

- Overgrowing vegetation
- Seating improvements Nr Orwell Church, Ba' Hill
- Anti-social behaviour near church
- Roads maintenance
- Seating at community woodland
- Parking
- Roads maintenance
- Market area redevelopment

Zone 5 Priorities

- General Maintenance
- Give way markings at cross / Stirling Road brought forward
- Pathway at Marshall Place for resident's bins

Donaldson Park

- Paint park entrance gates
- Improve entranceway
- Improve playthings, benches and hill/hump
- Make the park bigger and better

Dog issues

- More dog bins & signs needed throughout Milnathort

War Memorial Improvements

- Improvements to lawns, new gravel, plant spring bulbs & look at climbing plants
- Check monument by stone mason and produce report on maintenance required
- Polish name plates
- Repair decayed fence

Street Lighting

- More street lighting, especially in the park
- Lighting in Marshall Place archway
- Paint lampposts in all Zone 5 areas

Gateways

- Move Milnathort village signs out past Burleigh Castle or the defined start of Milnathort
- Milnathort sign at Auld Mart & entrance
- Stirling Road village gateway proposal

Zone 2 Priorities

- Resurfacing at recycling bank
- Safety work at entrance/exit from park to Victoria Ave
- Build ramp at southern access to the "wee park"
- Redesign and relocate goal posts away from children's swings.
- Overall improvements to play park & back loan refurbishments
- Think of ways to make Back Loan more "pedestrian friendly"
- Pedestrian safety/traffic calming issues

Youth Priorities

- Youth shelter
- Public toilets
- More dog bins

Litter issues

- Litter at food outlets
- Litter pick needed

Zone 3 Priorities

- Clear out the drains at the bottom of Mayfield Gardens and Balfour Crescent
- Manage Community Woodland Path at Burleigh
- Traffic Calming on Burleigh Road
- Resurface and improve the footpath along Burleigh Road
- Better signage and joining up of footpath at the Stackyard, Burleigh Castle and the community woodland
- Replace bollards at Perth Road/Burleigh Road junction with planters/flower pots.

Children's Priorities

- Make the park bigger and better
- More dog bins everywhere
- More street lighting, especially in the park
- Make the war memorial prettier
- Clean up of rubbish and chewing gum on streets

Overgrown vegetation

- Remove and trim back overhanging branches and hedges throughout Milnathort
