The car park site is located in the area known as Bannerfield in Kirkmichael, Perthshire. The site lies to the south of and directly adjacent to the bridge over the River Ardlie in the centre of Kirkmichael.

The works to be carried out under this contract consist of the construction of a short section of access road, a 21 space car parking area with an integral area to accommodate a recycling facility, drainage and headwall and two new picnic areas and tables on a small landscaped area adjacent to the new car park.

Additional works comprise the supply and installation of direction signs and information boards.

The works also include the relocation of a street lighting column and the diversion and undergrounding of Electricity supply cables.

Applications to tender are invited from suitably experienced and qualified contractors to construct the car park and associated facilities.

Contractors must be registered with Constructionline and CHAS.

The works will be let on the basis of a priced contract with bill of quantities.

Contract award will be based on the most economically advantageous terms for the Council.
