Services for Children and their Families who have a Profound Disability



Current Respite Provision includes:

Community-based Respite provided by:

We Care Perthshire

We Care Perthshire is a service provided by the Child Health Team and offers befriending, sitting and support at home. Our volunteers spend one-on-one time with a child or young person doing various activities in their community or in their home.

Groovy Gang

The Groovy Gang is a service provided by the Child Health Team and run by staff and volunteers. The service provides group work and activities during the school holidays for children and young people involved with the Child Health Team.

Direct Payments

This scheme enables families to employ their own carer for community-based respite. Families may already know of someone who can offer support to their child.

Crossroads and Enable

Both of these services are community-based where a carer will spend one-to-one time with a child doing an agreed activity, or caring for a child at their home. This allows the parent to go out, or spend time with any other children they may have.

SPLASH Playscheme

This is a school holiday playscheme for children with profound or complex needs. One week at Easter and five weeks in the summer holidays and one week in October. All children are supported on a one-to-one basis with fully trained volunteers.

Residential Respite at:

Woodlea Cottage

This is a specially-built property in Perth which is supported by trained and experienced staff. The home can accommodate four children in a safe and pleasant environment for short overnight respite breaks.

Short Breaks

Children can stay with an approved respite carer in their home, either during the day, or for 1-2 overnight stays per month. All Short Break carers are fully assessed by the Family Placement Team.

If your child has been diagnosed with a profound physical or learning disability, or an illness which is chronic or life threatening, he/she may be eligible for an assessment by the Child Health Social Work Team.

The Child Health Social Work Team is made up of a Senior Social Worker, four full-time Social Workers and one Senior Social Care Officer. This team has a responsibility to carry out individual assessments based on the child/young person's level of disability and the impact of this on the child and his/her family. The team offer information, advice, support and access to respite resources.

The child will be involved in their assessment, (taking into account their level of understanding), so that their views can be considered. We aim to work in partnership with parents and families throughout the assessment process. In agreement with parents we will also have contact with other Services who are involved with the child, eg Nursery, School and Health Services.

Respite provision comes in a variety of forms, depending on the needs of the child and family and on the resources available.
