

CONDITIONS OF LET (continued)

- No games will be played when the ground is considered unsuitable. This will be determined by a Council Official. For periods of bad weather please refer to the winter cancellation procedures.
- If a team or referee considers a booked pitch to be unsuitable for play an alternative pitch should not be used unless permission has been given by a Council Official prior to kick-off.
- The Council will not be held responsible for any losses incurred by a team as a result of the pitch being deemed unsuitable for play.
- If a game is cancelled, you must notify the office on (01738) 476476. 24 hours notice is required otherwise the full charge will be payable or a game deducted from the seasonal allowance.
- In the event of a number of fixtures being cancelled due to weather conditions, the playing season on selected pitches may be extended at the discretion of the Council, until Sunday 29th May 2011.
- In no circumstances will the Council accept responsibility for the loss, theft, and damage of or to any goods or property of the Hirer or any visitor to the South Inch premises.
- The Hirer shall indemnify the Council, their officers and servants against all claims, demands, actions or proceedings in respect of the death of or injury to any person or damage to, loss of property belonging to any person arising out of the use of the South Inch changing pavilion otherwise than as a result of the defective condition of the pavilion or the Council's equipment or the negligence of the Council, its agents, officers or servants.

CONDITIONS OF LET (continued)

- If the hirer omits or refuses to comply with these conditions or with any reasonable instructions given to him/her by Perth & Kinross Council, or designated officer, for the time being he/she and any person/s associated with him/her may be excluded from the premises until he/she complies with the same but without relieving him/her from their other obligations under this Agreement. The Council shall be entitled to retain for their own use and benefit any monies paid by way of deposit and to sue for any balance outstanding.

WINTER CANCELLATION PROCEDURES

- No games will be played when ground conditions are considered unsuitable as determined by a representative of The Environment Service whose decision will be final. This decision cannot be overruled by any match official.
- If teams are in any doubt whether games will be played, they are advised to call the Football Pavilion Attendant (Tel:07707751382) between 9.30-10.30 am (Sat/Sun) when a decision will have been made.
- A Council representative will visit each site throughout the weekend to ensure that no teams are playing on pitches deemed unsuitable.
- The home team will be responsible for ensuring that all litter is collected and disposed of safely after matches – the Council Litter Officers will monitor this.

SERVICE CHARTER

Perth and Kinross Council is committed to providing quality services to its customers. The following are the standards we have set for our football pitches and facilities and how we aim to achieve them.

A Clean and Safe Environment

- Emptying litter and dog waste bins as required and at least twice per week.
- Pitches and facilities to be free from vandalism, graffiti and litter.
- Providing pathways which are clean and free from litter.

Well Maintained Sport Pitches

- Cutting grass on a fortnightly basis (this may be varied to reflect seasonal weather variations).
- Evenly spreading grass clippings.
- Marking of all pitches with clear white lines.
- Ensuring posts are straight and vertical
- Maintaining playing pitches to provide a good, safe playing surface.

Well Maintained Changing Rooms

- Ensuring changing rooms are clean, tidy and available for use when required.
- Providing sufficient warm water for shower users.
- Ensuring toilets are clean, stocked with consumables and inspected on a regular basis.

Effective Administration

- Provision for enquiries and bookings during office hours, 8.45am to 5.00pm, Monday to Friday.
- Accurate and prompt administration including processing of invoices, receipts and booking forms.
- Supporting the work of the Football Clubs.

CONDITIONS OF LET

- Saturday **21st August 2010** to Sunday **9th May 2011** is the playing season covered by this agreement. Goals are scheduled to be erected between 2nd to 13th August with the exception of South Inch between 16th to 20th August 2010.
- Changing facilities at the South Inch will be provided for the duration of this agreement for Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday fixtures only.
- A seasonal booking will allow a maximum of 22 home matches. Any additional games will be charged for accordingly at the 'per game' rate.
- No booking will be confirmed until receipt of the appropriate fee. This should be returned no later than **Friday 13th August 2010**. Payments made by instalments will incur VAT charges.
- The Club and the Secretaries names which appear on the Application Form shall be deemed to be the Hirer and shall be responsible for compliance with all rules, regulations or requirements made or laid down from time to time by the Council in respect of the use of the grounds and premises and shall be deemed to be the responsible person nominated to be in charge during the hire.
- Pitches cannot be sub-let without prior permission of the Council.
- Pitch bookings – Weekend pitch bookings will only be accepted after 8.45am on Monday mornings of the same week. Weekday matches can be booked a week in advance.
- Pitches are let on a "first-come-first-served basis". You may not always get your first choice, but you will always be offered an alternative.
