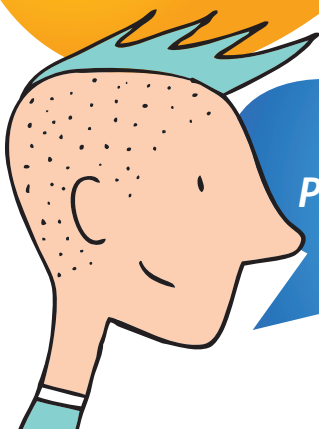

My name is Lisa. I've been excluded from school and I've to go to a children's hearing. What are my rights?

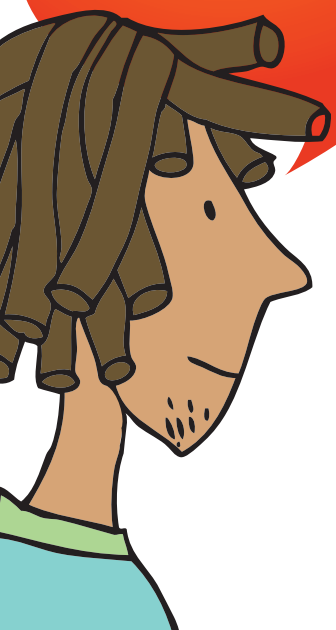
My name is Jason. I'm living with foster parents at the moment but I'm not happy where I am. Can I move?



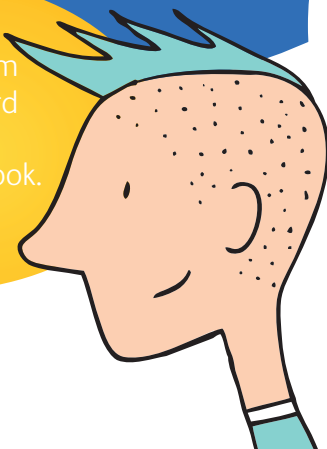
What We Do

- Make people aware of the rights of young people in a variety of ways (workshops, informal activities, talks, drop-ins)
- Provide advice and information for parents, carers and other professionals about youth rights
