## 326. APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE EXECUTIVE SUB-COMMITTEE

## 327. PERTH AND KINROSS COMMUNITY SAFETY STRATEGY 2007-2012

There was submitted a report by the Head of Strategic Management and Improvement (07/407) presenting the Perth and Kinross Community Safety Strategy for 2007/2012 which built on the work of the previous strategy to introduce sustainable community safety outcomes achieved through effective partnership working and seeking approval of the strategy.

### **Resolved:**

The Perth and Kinross Community Safety Strategy 2007-2012, as detailed in Appendix to Report 07/407, be endorsed and supported.

## 328. ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REVIEW OF THE PERTH AND KINROSS ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR OUTCOME AGREEMENT

There was submitted a report by the Executive Director (Housing and Community Care) (07/408) outlining the first Annual Performance Review of the Perth and Kinross Antisocial Behaviour Outcome Agreement and requesting its endorsement.

### **Resolved:**

- (i) The Annual Report of Perth and Kinross Antisocial Behaviour Outcome Agreement, as set out in Appendices B and C to Report 07/408 be endorsed.
- (ii) The Convener write to the Minister for Communities and Sport urging continuation of the funding beyond 2008 to ensure that the positive improvement already made can be maintained.

**329. BYELAWS PROHIBITING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES**

There was submitted a report by the Executive Director (Housing and Community Care) (07/409) identifying resources to support the consultation process and subsequent implementation of Byelaws banning the consumption of alcohol in public places.

**Resolved:**

- (i) A consultation be undertaken with the relevant communities on the promotion of Byelaws prohibiting the consumption of alcohol in public places in the areas of Aberfeldy, Dunkeld and Birnam, Coupar Angus, Scone and Errol.
- (ii) A report on the findings of the consultation be submitted to the meeting of the Community Safety Committee on 28 November 2007 detailing the responses received.

**330. INTER AGENCY PROTOCOL FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF SERIOUS OFFENDERS IN PERTH AND KINROSS (MAPPA)**

There was submitted a report by the Executive Director (Housing and Community Care) (07/410) seeking approval for measures designed to improve risk assessment and management arrangements in relation to persons assessed as presenting a significant threat to community safety.

J Gilruth, Lead Officer, Criminal Justice and Additions Service, gave a short presentation on the Protocol.

**Resolved:**

The Managing Serious Offenders Protocol for Perth and Kinross, setting out the roles and responsibilities of key agencies and structures employed in managing the risk presented by persons known to present a significant threat to community safety, be approved.

**331. HOUSING AND COMMUNITY CARE BUSINESS MANAGEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT PLAN (BMIP) 2007-2010**
