

To reflect the national priorities for Community Learning and Development, the Action Plan is in three sections:

Achievement through learning for adults

- Provide opportunities for adults to improve their reading, writing and numeracy skills.
- Provide support for adults to develop their core skills including their computing skills.
- Support our migrant workers to develop their speaking, writing and reading in English.
- Offer guidance and support to enable adults and their families to access and participate in learning opportunities.
- Ensure there are adult learning opportunities for the more marginalised adults in our communities.



Achievement through learning for young people

- Develop and deliver a wide range of services for young people which will reflect the needs of the young people.
- Develop and deliver a range of positive learning experiences and outcomes for young people, including access to accreditation.
- Support young people 16+ to move towards a positive destination.
- Increase opportunities for young people to access information which they can use to make positive life choices.
- Provide support which will enable young people to become more active and responsible within their communities.

Achievement through building community capacity

- Develop and deliver a range of training, enabling people to have more skills, and knowledge, which they can use to be active in their community.
- Organise the local Better Place to Live Fair providing an opportunity for community members, groups and organisations to celebrate achievement, network and showcase the activities they provide in the area.
- Increase opportunities for community involvement in local Partnership Groups
- Promote & support community celebration in the rural villages, settlements & the Loch Leven Community Campus.
- Ensure the Partnership Group reflects the local communities and services of Kinross-shire.
- Support joint working projects within the CLD group to promote healthy active lifestyles in the community.
