

Milnathort Placecheck

Priorities Identified 29/8/09

Zone 1

Short Term

1. Overgrowing Vegetation and grass
2. Seating
3. Anti- social behaviour

Medium Term

1. Roads maintenance
2. seating
3. Litter + food outlets

Long Term

1. Parking – general: Town Hall, Church, Bowling Club
2. Roads maintenance
3. Market area redevelopment :
 - speed limit 20mph
 - change of priorities on N. Street
 - build outs to improve visibility
 - one way system (zone 2)

Zone 2

Short Term

1. Resurfacing at recycling bank to avoid ponding of water in front of bins
2. Safety work at entrance/exit from park to Victoria Ave (wooden fencing)
3. Dog bin needed and “dog” sign

Medium Term

1. Build ramp at southern access to the “wee park” (back loan)
2. Redesign and relocate goal posts away from children’s swings.
3. Youth Shelter – small building at ? 1 New Road – who owns it?

Long Term

1. Overall improvements to play park & back loan refurbishments – dog bins, rubber matting, redesign.
2. Council to think of ways to make Back Loan more “pedestrian friendly”
3. Pedestrian safety/traffic calming issues:
 - Build out with flower tub at 38 New Road for access sight line improvements
 - New Road next to Burleigh Rd on South side build out for improved pedestrian visibility
 - Victoria Ave – pavement & road widening
 - Perth Rd – staggered buildouts at Asaley House to slow traffic both ways
 - Traffic Calming Perth Rd/New Rd (build out New Rd. Perth Rd)
 - Victoria Ave Pavement (S.Side + rebuild wall on N. Side)

Zone3

Short Term

1. Remove and trim back overhanging branches and the hedges along Burleigh Road. In particular the hedge at No.16;
2. Clear out the drains at the bottom of Mayfield Gardens and Balfour Crescent;
3. Community Woodland Path Management/litter pickup.

Medium Term

1. Moving 'Milnathort' village signs out past Burleigh Castle or the defined start of Milnathort;
2. Traffic Calming on Burleigh Road (light up 30 mph signs)
3. Traffic mirror at the bottom of Mayfield Gardens & Balfour Crescent, if the traffic calming is effective this may not be needed. Dog bins at the community woodland would be the other option.

Long Term

1. Resurface and improve the footpath along Burleigh Road;
2. Better signage and joining up of footpath at the Stackyard, Burleigh Castle and the community woodland;
3. Replace bollards at Perth Road/Burleigh Road junction with planters/flower pots.

Zone 4 – South Street

Short Term

1. Road markings (yellow/white) - Church St / Roundabout / Old Mart / bus stops
2. Paint Donaldson Park entrance gates – improve entrance, chips/sign post on road 70/83, flowers (more than just crocus')
3. Dog Bins at entrance Golf Club/ Royal Bank and Old Mart entrance of Moss Road. South/Station Yard replace bin with a dog bin & tidy banking

Medium Term

1. Pedestrian crossings – Church Street & Bridgefauld Road (by Milnathort Motors), tidy up car park & railings at entrance – remove kerb stones etc
2. Milnathort sign at Auld Mart & entrance feature
3. Bus Stop at No. 67 – Community information boards on sides, historical signs/info (keep glass free), light inside, floral addition

Long Term

1. Picnic tables, benches, fruit trees and wild flowers at entrance to cycle path and the Weir triangle. Clear path edges – thin trees and shrubs on paths down to burn, plant wild flowers
2. Between 90-94 (open space) to be used for a community garden
3. South Street layout :
 - widen path at no 55

- raise curb for flood prevention at No. 55,
- move lamp standard at entrance to Moss rd (H0746)
- widen pavement in front of no 74
- cycle route/pavement part Lethangie to high School (E. Side of Road)

Zone 5

Short Term

1. Litter pick
2. Lighting in Marshall Place archway
3. General maintenance list:
 - Dog fouling, loose concrete step outside 7 Crawford Place
 - tree pruning at Stirling Rd/Church Street & cross & car park Kay Trailers & Whyte place corner no.44
 - dog fouling outside school/Stirling Rd & Donaldson park Play bark
 - weeds
 - loose telegraph pole support DB53 Stirling Road

Medium Term

1. Give way markings at cross / Stirling Road brought forward
2. Paint lampposts in all Zone 5 areas
3. Pathway at Marshall Place for resident's bins

Long Term

1. Stirling Road village gateway proposal (plans available)
2. Donaldson Park (Playthings, benches, hill/hump)
3. War memorial improvements:
 - edging border around lawns
 - have grass cut more frequently, feed and weed grass,
 - new coloured gravel round memorial,
 - check monument by stone mason and produce report on maintenance required
 - polish name plates
 - new gravel on side path
 - spring bulbs on 3 sides with the shrubs and trees
 - climbing plants on back wall
 - repair decayed fence

Youth Placecheck

1. Youth shelter
2. Public toilets
3. More dog bins

Children's Placecheck

1. Make the park bigger and better
2. More dog bins everywhere

3. More street lighting , especially in the park.
4. Make the war memorial prettier. E.g. more flowers , plants.
5. Clean up of rubbish and chewing gum on streets
