Travelling To Perth

IT'S EASY to come to Perth by car with a wide range of safe and secure short stay car parks within the city centre. If you wish to stay all day, follow signs for South Inch, Canal Street or Kinross Street car parks. All of these car parks are a short walk from the High Street.

A Park + Ride service operates between Bracken on the Glasgow Road approach to Perth and Perth city centre. This quick and easy alternative to using the car in the city saves costs £1 return journey and provides a limited stop express service.

Free parking spaces for the use of blue badge holders are provided on the pavement of the pedestrianised area in High Street, St John's area and King Edward Street. The Signage scheme provides free hire of wheelchairs and powered scooters. It is operated from the Canal Street multi-storey car park 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday (Tel: 01738 703960).

Perth Railway Station is only a few minutes walk from the city centre. Contact 08457 404950 or www.nationalrail.co.uk for train times.

Perth can be reached by a network of fast and reliable coach services. In addition, local bus operators provide frequent links to Perth from most local towns. 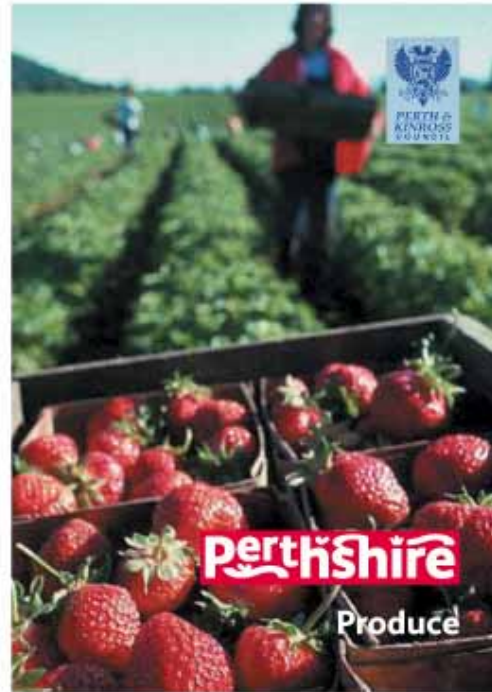
