186. MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING

IN TERMS OF STANDING ORDER 6, COUNCILLOR R ELLIS DECLARED A NON-FINANCIAL INTEREST IN THE FOLLOWING ITEM

187. VISITSCOTLAND PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT 2011/2012

There was submitted a report by the Executive Director (Environment) (11/143) outlining the basis for the 2011/12 Partnership Agreement between VisitScotland and Perth and Kinross Council, and the tourism information related services which will be undertaken with the Council's financial support.

Resolved:

- (i) The 2011/12 Partnership Agreement with VisitScotland and the funding of £165,000 in support of the tourism information services as set out in Report 11/143 be approved, subject to budget.
- (ii) The Tourist Information Consultative Group continue to engage with VisitScotland in order to review the management of the information centre network and to jointly develop the strategy in respect of services for visitors in Perth and Kinross.

- (iii) It be remitted to the Executive Director (Environment) to report back on recommendations in respect of the strategic direction for visitor information services to a future meeting of the Enterprise and Infrastructure Committee.

188. DUNKELD CONSERVATION AREA APPRAISAL

There was submitted a report by the Depute Director (Environment) (11/144) introducing the final draft of the Dunkeld Conservation Area Appraisal.

Resolved:

The final draft of Dunkeld Conservation Area Appraisal, as appended to Report 11/144, and the proposed boundary and associated management measures, be approved and progressed onto formal re-designation by notifying Scottish Ministers.

189. BRIDGE OF EARN PROPOSED EXTENSION OF 30MPH SPEED LIMIT ON THE C416 WICKS O' BAIGLIE ROAD

There was submitted a report by the Depute Director (Environment) (11/145) (1) outlining the situation with regard to the speed limit on the C416 Wicks O' Baiglie Road in Kintillo, Bridge of Earn; and (2) recommending that a Traffic Regulation Order be promoted to allow the 30mph speed limit to be extended.

The promotion of a variation to the relevant Traffic Regulation Order to extend the 30 mph speed limit on the C416 Wicks O' Baiglie Road, Kintillo, Bridge of Earn, as outlined in Report 11/145, be approved.
