# LIGHTNIGHT TRAVEL

## Getting the bus to Lightnight within Perth

Perth residents can buy a ticket on the normal Stagecoach Perth city buses to travel from residential areas into the city centre. Lightnight finale ends in Tay Street at 21.25. Stagecoach Perth will be providing free buses departing from Mill Street between 21.30 and 22.15 to the following areas:

- Muirton/North Muirton
- Tulloch
- Letham/Burghmuir
- Oakbank/Western Edge
- Craigie/Moncrieffe

## Perth Park + Ride

If travelling by car from outwith Perth to visit Lightnight, why not use Perth Park+Ride service and avoid problems of finding a parking place in the city centre? The Park+Ride site is located on the Glasgow Road approach to Perth adjacent to the Broxden roundabout - giving easy access to the M90, A9 and A85.

Parking at the Park+Ride site is free of charge. The bus operator, Smith & Sons, will be operating the Park+Ride buses between Broxden and the city centre free of charge from 18.00 until 22.15. Buses will operate every 20 minutes.

## Buses to Perth from other Scottish cities

Megabus.com use the Broxden Park+Ride site as an interchange for their buses operating to Glasgow, Edinburgh, Dundee, Aberdeen and Inverness. Megabus.com passengers can use the Perth Park+Ride service for journeys to/from Perth City Centre on payment of the appropriate fare to the driver or by showing your prepaid through travel ticket, purchased from Megabus.com.

Outwith the Perth Park+Ride operating times access to the car park will only be permitted during Megabus.com service arrivals/departures. Megabus.com passengers parking at the site should use the upper level of the car park.

## Cycling

Covered shelter racks for bicycles can be found at Kinnoull Street Multi-Storey Car Park, North Port (between Concert Hall and Museum), Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park (ground floor near vehicular exit), Bus Station and AK Bell Library.

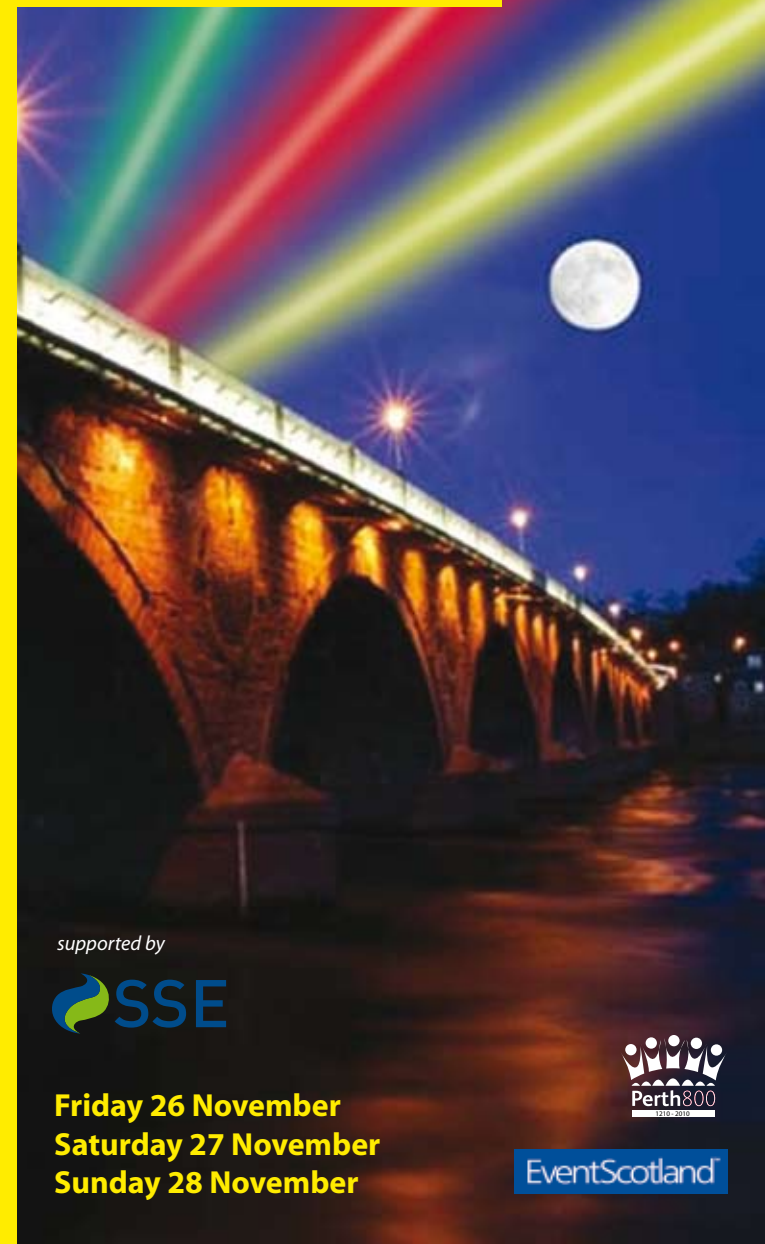
