### **392. APPLICATIONS FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

There was submitted a report by the Executive Director (Corporate Services) (08/358) on applications received for financial assistance.

#### **Resolved:**

- (a) Aberfeldy and District Gaelic Choir**  
Aberfeldy and District Gaelic Choir be awarded a one off grant of £1,330 towards the cost of purchasing twenty new tartan skirts.
- (b) Aberfeldy Festive Committee**  
Aberfeldy Festive Committee be awarded a grant of £1,125 towards the cost of their Christmas Market and Hogmanay Celebrations Improvement Project 2008/09.
- (c) Breathe**  
Breathe be awarded a grant of £600 towards the cost of six young people from Aberfeldy attending the Sport Plus Project at Loretto School, Musselburgh from 6 – 11 July 2008.

**393. ABERFELDY SEMI AUTOMATIC PUBLIC CONVENIENCE INSTALLATION
