The centre offers an ideal base for school, youth or adult groups wishing to use the local resources for environmental or outdoor education, field studies, recreational or sporting activities. Excellent mountain and water resources are within easy reach, suitable for sailing, windsurfing, kayaking, Canadian canoeing, rock climbing, abseiling, hill and gorge walking.



This self-catering centre is simply, but comfortably furnished, adequately heated and accommodates up to 24 persons.



The centre is a converted schoolhouse situated alongside the B846 (OS Grid Ref. 664589). It is the first building on the right hand side of the road approaching Kinloch Rannoch from the east. In close proximity to the centre there is a post office, shop, hotels and doctor in the village.



Kinloch Rannoch is 20 miles from Pitlochry.

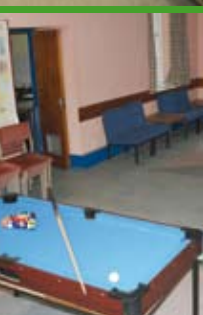
- 3 dormitories (sleep 6 each)
- 1 room (sleeps 4)
- 1 room (sleeps 2)
- 5 showers and 7 toilets (Showers and toilets are suitable for disabled access)



The kitchen is equipped with electric cooker, refrigerator/freezer, washing machine, cooking utensils and kitchen accessories. Crockery, cutlery, bed-linen (duvets, sheets and pillowcases) are provided but groups must supply their own food, washing up liquid and tea towels.



There are drying room facilities for items such as outdoor clothing etc.



The centre has a large room which is used as a dining area and leisure room.
