249. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest made in terms of the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

250. PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE PE150: T IN THE PARK MUSIC EVENT, BALADO AIRFIELD, KINROSS

There was submitted a report by the Chief Executive (08/227) requesting the Committee to consider the updated licensing conditions for the 2008 event, following recommendations made by the Multi-Agency Working Group.

The applicant and current licence holder appeared before the Committee and answered Members' questions. Representatives of the Chief Constable, the Chief Fire Officer, the Scottish Ambulance Service and Perth and Kinross Council's Environment Service also answered Members' questions.

Resolved:

- (i) Following the recommendations made by the Multi-Agency Working Group, the 2008 licence conditions be approved.
- (ii) Powers be delegated to the Chief Executive of the Council, in consultation with the Convener of the Licensing Committee, to finalise any necessary adjustment to the conditions to attach to the licence for the 2008 event.
- (iii) The delegation of powers to the Chief Executive of the Council to review conditions attaching to the licence following the 2008 event in preparation for 2009, be continued.
- (iv) Powers be delegated to the Chief Executive to reach, where necessary, agreement with the holders of the licence on the matter of costs incurred by the Council.
- (v) It be noted that officers were engaged in a comprehensive revision of the conditions with the aim of simplifying them, while clarifying areas of

responsibility and maintaining the current high standard of public safety requirements.

- (vi) It be further agreed to reaffirm the decision made by the Committee at its meeting on 13 February 2008, that written assurance be required from the applicant that there will be put in place a robust programme of structures erection with adequately resourced controls to ensure that the build is complete in advance of the relevant opening times.
