<i>1. Annual Licence</i>	<i>£110</i>
<i>2. Licence for specified period exceeding 3 months and 3 weeks.</i>	<i>£110 (or specific charge prepared in regard to larger premises or events).</i>
<i>3. Licence for specified period of less than 3 months and 3 weeks.</i>	
<i>(a) for each complete month or part of a month exceeding 3 weeks.</i>	<i>£25</i>
<i>(b) for each complete week of part of a week not taken into account in (a) above.</i>	<i>£10</i>
<i>4. Occasional Licence</i>	
<i>(a) for particular occasions falling on not more than 7 different days.</i>	<i>£10</i>
<i>(b) for particular occasions falling on more than 7 different days.</i>	<i>The amount that would have been payable if the application were for a licence for a specified period (as in (3) above) equal to the aggregate number of days on which the particular occasions fall.</i>
<i>5. Transfer of Licence</i>	<i>£25 (except that the fee shall not exceed the fee that would be payable if the application were for the grant of a licence for the rest of the period for which the licence is in force).</i>
