

ALTERATIONS TO GRITTING AND SNOWCLEARING ARRANGEMENTS IN KINLOCH RANNOCH WHILE B846 IS CLOSED BETWEEN BALMORE AND BOHESPIC JUNCTIONS FOR SCOTTISH WATER OPERATIONS

Perth and Kinross Council operates a priority system for winter maintenance whereby roads are categorised according to their usage and importance in the network. Category 1 roads are treated seven days per week, between 6am and 9pm (8am and 9pm on Sundays and Public Holidays). Category 2 roads are treated on weekdays (excluding Public Holidays) between 7.30am and 3pm, after Category 1 roads are completed.

The normal arrangements in the Kinloch Rannoch area are as follows

- o B846 from Kinloch Rannoch to Tummel Bridge is a Category 1 road.
- o B847 and the Bohespic road are Category 2 roads. However B847 from Calvine to Balmore is incorporated within the Category 1 route from Blair Atholl to Aberfeldy for route efficiency.

While the B846 closure is in operation, traffic will be diverted round by Bohespic and B847.

The gritting arrangements will be as follows.

- o The Aberfeldy gritter will normally be past in the morning before Scottish Water start work, so it will get through the closed section of B846 before the school bus. (shown red on the map below)
- o The Rannoch gritter comes along Strathtummel and it will divert round by Bohespic and B847 (the diversion route) before continuing to Kinloch Rannoch. (shown blue on the map below)

In snow conditions, when repeated treatment is required, Bohespic and B847 will become part of the Rannoch gritter's Category 1 route (shown blue) and receive repeat treatment. The closed section of B846 will become Category 2 so it will only be treated when the Category 1 route is satisfactory. It will however be treated before the afternoon run of the school bus.
