Community Campus Partnerships

As part of the ongoing development of the community campus we are setting up a Campus Partnership to ensure the views of the users and the community are heard.

What is a Campus Partnership?

A Campus Partnership is a group which represents and reflects the views of Campus users and the local community.

What is the role of the Campus Partnership?

The role of the Partnership is to promote the Campus and its ethos to the local community, influencing change and improvements to the quality of services delivered from the Campus and reflecting the needs of the community.

Who will be involved in the Partnership?

The Campus Partnership will draw its membership from as wide a cross section of Campus users and local community organisations as possible including young people, families, older people, people with sporting, learning, cultural and recreational interests and a representative from local Community Councils. Local councillors will be invited to become members of the Partnership. The Campus Leader will be invited to attend meetings in order to maintain good links with the Community Campus Management Group.

What powers will the Partnership have?

The Campus Partnership will be an advisory body which supports Campus development.

How will views be represented?

Comments, views and concerns of the Campus Partnership will be reported to the Community Campus Management Group through the Campus Leader.

What will be the benefits for the community?

This is an opportunity for local people to be involved in shaping the future of the campus and its services. This will help ensure the Campus plays a key role in community life.

What will the Campus Partnership members be expected to do?

As a local person you will be expected to reflect the views of the local community and to feed back to any community groups you are involved in.

What support will be available?



The local Community Capacity Building Worker will attend Partnership meetings in order to provide support. Meetings will take place in the Campus. Creche facilities can be provided if required.
