

PERTH AND KINROSS LICENSING BOARD

SUPPLEMENTARY LICENSING POLICY STATEMENT

Under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005, Section 6 Perth and Kinross Licensing Board has adopted a Supplementary Licensing Policy Statement as follows:-

- (1) In terms of Paragraph 7.7 of the Board's Policy Statement (2007 – 10) the terminal licensed hours for premises offering significant entertainment facilities for Friday and Saturday nights shall be extended to 3am from 1 June 2010 until a further review is completed. That review will commence after the end of the Board's festive hours period for 2010-11. Premises affected may apply to operate those hours by way of extended hours requests.

After the end of the Board's festive hours period for 2010-11, Tayside Police shall be requested to provide statistical information on any incidents during the experimental period up to the end of the Board's festive hours period for 2010-11 compared to previous comparable periods and a further consultation will be conducted for a period of six weeks on either reverting to the status quo (2.30am on Friday and Saturday nights) or a permanent change as has operated during the experimental period, with a Report then being submitted to the Board for a final decision; and

- (2) Paragraph 7.7 of the Board's Policy Statement (2007 – 10) is amended as follows:-

After the table setting out the terminal licensed hours for premises offering significant entertainment add as follows:-

Where Christmas Eve and Hogmanay do not fall on a Friday or Saturday night the terminal licensed hour for those nights will be the same as for the Friday and Saturday festive period terminal licensed hour as set out in the table above.
