**STRATEGIC ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (SEA) SCREENING REPORT FOR
THE PERTH & KINROSS STRUCTURE PLAN ALTERATION N°1 – INDICATIVE
FORESTRY STRATEGY**

Please find attached four copies of Perth and Kinross Council's SEA Screening Report for the above document.

As an alteration to a plan which has been prepared for town and country planning or land use purposes, it falls under Regulation 9(a) of The Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes (Scotland) Regulations 2004 and as such does not require a Screening Report to be produced.
