

Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005

A full Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) has been undertaken for the Pitlochry Conservation Area Appraisal and the plan was adopted on 27 June 2007.

SEA legislation requires the Council to consider whether any plans, programmes or strategies it produces will have any significant effects on the environment. An SEA Environmental Report has been prepared in conjunction with the plan and has sought to avoid, minimise or mitigate for any environmental impacts. A public consultation on the Environmental Report and draft plan was held and all comments received have been addressed. This statement fulfils the duty of the Council to bring the adoption of this plan to the attention of the public under Section 18(1b) of the Act.
