## 113. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no Declarations of Interest made in terms of the Councillors' Code of Conduct.

## 114. T IN THE PARK – PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE

There was submitted a report by the Chief Executive (07/171) advising of (1) an application by Big Day Out for renewal of a three year Public Entertainment Licence and variation of conditions in respect of the T In The Park music event at Balado Airfield, Kinross; (2) the consultation and assessment process employed by the Council as Licensing Authority and its partners through a Multi-Agency Working Group, attended by the Convener of this Committee as an observer; (3) the need for appropriate delegated powers to be given to the Chief Executive and Executive Director (Corporate Services), in consultation with the Convener of the Licensing Committee, to issue a licence with the appropriate conditions attached, these conditions to be subject to annual review, and (4) possible conditions proposed to attach to the Licence.

The Applicant and current Licence Holder appeared before the Committee and answered Members' questions. Representatives of the Chief Constable, the Chief Fire Officer, the Scottish Ambulance Service and Perth and Kinross Council Environment Service also answered Members' questions.

THE COMMITTEE ADJOURNED TO DISCUSS THE REPRESENTATIONS RECEIVED.

THE COMMITTEE RECONVENED.

### **Resolved:**

- (i) The application by Big Day Out for renewal of a three year Public Entertainment Licence and variation of conditions in respect of the T In The Park event at Balado Airfield, Kinross, be approved.
- (ii) The draft conditions, as recommended by the Multi-Agency Working Group, be approved.
- (iii) Powers be delegated to the Chief Executive of the Council, in consultation with the Convener of the Licensing Committee, to attach appropriate conditions to the Licence, those conditions to be subject to annual review.
- (iv) Powers be delegated to the Executive Director (Corporate Services) to reach, where necessary, agreement with the applicants on the matter of costs incurred by the Council, prior to the issue of the Licence.

Note: Councillor A Grant moved that the application be granted subject to the requested increase of 5,000 extra ticket sales for Saturday 7 July 2007 and Sunday 8 July 2007 being refused. On failing to find a seconder, Councillor Grant's Amendment fell.
