90. MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING

91. APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

There was submitted a report by the Depute Director (Environment) (11/62) on applications received for financial assistance.

Resolved:

(a) Highland Perthshire Cycling

- (i) The offer to award a grant of £500 to Highland Perthshire Cycling towards the cost of staging the Highland Perthshire Cycling Big Day in Aberfeldy event in 2010 be recinded. (Art 101/10 refers)
- (ii) The sum of £500 be made available, as required, to Highland Perthshire Cycling on the basis of an after-the-event guarantee against loss for the 2011 Highland Perthshire Cycling Big Day in Aberfeldy.

(b) Breadalbane Academy Ceildh Band

Breadalbane Academy Ceildh Band be awarded a grant of £200 towards the cost of purchasing equipment for the Band.

92. FINANCIAL STATEMENT

There was submitted a report by the Head of Finance (11/63) detailing the income and expenditure on the Aberfeldy Common Good Fund for the period up to 31 January 2011, anticipating a surplus of £5,775 in financial year 2010/2011, and projecting a balance on the Fund's Revenue Account of £94,951 at 31 March 2011. The Committee noted the final sentence in paragraph 4 of Report 11/63 *Significant variations from the approved budget include a £6,000 donation from the Environment Service for trees at Kirkgate Park* had been included within the report in error, and as
