# Household Waste Presentation

Wheeled bins will only be uplifted if they are presented appropriately as detailed below.



- *Ensure that wheeled bins are placed at the kerbside or agreed location by 7.30 am on the morning of your collection.*
- *Ensure that bins are returned to your property as soon as possible after emptying or they may be removed.*



- *Do not overfill bins and ensure that the lid is fully closed.*
- *Your bin will not be uplifted if it is too heavy to be safely moved.*
- *Do not leave excess waste on top of your bin as neither the waste nor your bin will be uplifted.*



- *Do not leave excess waste next to your bin as it will not be uplifted.*

**Do not put the following in your wheeled bins:** Hot ashes, building rubble, soil, large metal objects, corrosive material/liquids, large tree branches, or paint (unless it has dried out).

If you feel you have insufficient bin capacity, the following options are available:

- **Recycling Centres and Points**

*Your local Recycling Centres and Points accept a wide variety of materials for recycling. Excess household waste can be disposed of free of charge at Recycling Centres.*

- **Blue or Brown-Lidded Bin**

*Your kerbside recycling service allows around 50% of your waste to be recycled. If you make full use of your blue and/or brown-lidded bin, your green-lidded bin should not become over full. If you feel you need them, you can request a second blue and/or brown-lidded bin. See below for contact details.*

- **Charities and Reuse Projects**

*There are a number of charities and reuse projects in Perth and Kinross that will accept a wide variety of quality second-hand materials.
