

Contaminated Land

Service Objectives

- To inspect the Council's area for the purposes of identifying contaminated land sites
- To establish who may be the appropriate persons to bear responsibility for remediation and wherever possible secure voluntary redemption of the land
- To carry out a risk assessment of contaminated land sites in order to apply a classification scheme for prioritisation.
- To complete and maintain a public register of contaminated land.
- To implement and review the Council's Contaminated Land Inspection Strategy
- To ensure appropriate and best practice remediation methods are implemented.
- To provide advice to Planning and Development Control on matters relating to the development of land that may be contaminated.
- To respond to complaints and requests for service from service users and members of the public relating to the development of contaminated land.
