The Provost's Walk from the Public Park in Auchterarder along the bridle path to Abbey Road is roughly 2.5km long. Toilets are available at Crown Wynd in the High Street.



Wheelchair users should join the path at the foot of Ruthven Street, since parts of the steep path from the recycling centre down to the bridle path have deep rills where the finer stones have been washed away.

This section of the path ends in a considerable flight of steps before levelling off and continuing east along the side of the Lade.




The path follows the contour of the land and is generally fairly level.



At the foot of Ruthven Street the path forks and although signposted it may be unclear which route to take. Choose the path which continues to the left of the Lade. From here the walk becomes very scenic with the burn bubbling along beside the path.



At Linden Coach House, wheelchair users should continue east along the metalled road and head back into town via Abbey Road.



Unfortunately, at the time of writing this guide, the section of path to the west of Ruthvenvale Terrace behind Linden Coach House, was obstructed by a new Housing Development. There was, however, a rough path skirting the fenced building site.



The path continues around the extents of the building site.



The remainder of the original path to the town centre is still accessible and leads up hill behind the gardens of the bordering houses of Abbey Park and Milton Crescent.
