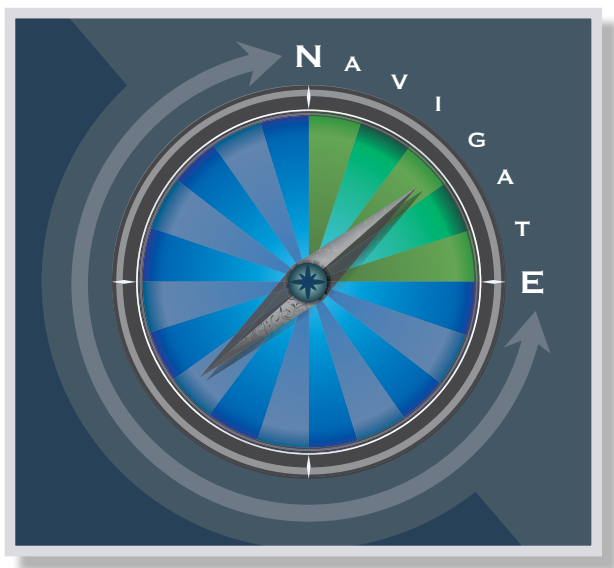


Our Vision

- *To work in Partnership with Perth and Kinross secondary schools to provide short term support for young people with complex social, emotional and behavioural difficulties.*

What does Navigate offer young people?

Each young person will have a keyworker to co-ordinate their support plan and ensure they are treated as an individual. Our teaching staff will support young people to engage in learning and gain National Qualifications and awards.

Young People will be supported to manage difficult life events so that their attention can be directed to positive progress.

What does Navigate offer families?

Navigate staff will work in partnership with parents and carers to support their child's education, growth and success.

What does Navigate offer schools?

Navigate provides an individual package of additional support and education for young people. The young person's mainstream school remains the key player in planning for the young person, in liaison with Navigate and other agencies who may be providing support.
