<b>Background Information</b>	In terms of the Act a licence is deemed to have been granted to an executor and shall, unless previously revoked, suspended or surrendered, remain in force until the end of a period of 3 months. The Committee may from time to time, on the application of the executor, extend or further extend that period if they are satisfied that the extension is necessary for the purpose of winding up the deceased's estate and that no other circumstances make it undesirable.
