P1. LETHAM COMMUNITY SPORTS CLUB

There was submitted a report by the Executive Director (Education and Children's Services) (14/31) providing an update on the proposals by Letham Community Sports Club to develop a full-sized synthetic turf pitch on the site of the existing sports fields at Seven Acres in Letham, Perth.

Resolved:

- (i) The terms of the letter of Undertaking, attached as Appendix 1 to Report 14/31, be approved for submission to sportscotland.
- (ii) An allocation of grant funding of up to £85,000 to be met from the Council's contingency budget be approved in principle (to meet the remaining shortfall in the project funding), subject to clarification of the position of the Perth Common Good Fund Committee on the possibility of a contribution towards the shortfall. Payment of the grant would be allocated to Letham Community Sports Club on a phased basis.
- (iii) The indicative financial risks to Perth and Kinross Council which had been identified in the event that the Club are unable to meet their projected income targets be noted and approved.
- (iv) It be delegated to the Executive Director (Education and Children's Services) to establish a project monitoring group as part of a legal agreement outlining conditions of the funding, and requiring the Club to provide quarterly financial reports to the Council.

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
