Out of Hours Transport

NHS Tayside has a local Out of Hours Primary Care Emergency Centre (PCEC) in Perth and 3 nurse-led Minor Injuries Units based in Blairgowrie, Crieff & Pitlochry. Patients are advised by NHS 24 to attend one of these treatment centres and if they are unable to travel independently, should advise NHS 24 of this when the appointment is arranged. NHS Tayside is empowered to provide transport to and from the transport centre for those in need. This service is not for universal use, but aimed at people without access to a car or family/friend to help.
