Dear Parent/Carer

In May 2019, a team of inspectors from Education Scotland visited Logiealmond Primary School. During our visit, we talked to parents/carers and children and worked closely with the headteacher and staff.

The inspection team found the following strengths in the school's work.

- Strong partnership working with parents and the wider community. This is providing relevant and meaningful learning contexts for children.
- Polite, confident and articulate children who are proud of their school. They are keen to contribute to improving their school and are developing a strong sense of their place in the wider community.
- The teamwork of the headteacher and staff in providing a nurturing and caring ethos. Their commitment to ensuring the wellbeing of every child is central to the work of the school.

The following areas for improvement were identified and discussed with the headteacher and a representative from Perth and Kinross Council.

- Build on the successful approaches in the 'We are Logiealmond!' project. This will provide further meaningful opportunities for children to lead significant aspects of their own learning.
- Continue to review the school's approaches to planning taking account of the school's unique context. In doing so, ensure children experience depth and progression across the curriculum.

We gathered evidence to enable us to evaluate the school's work using four quality indicators from [How good is our school? \(4<sup>th</sup> edition\)](#). Quality indicators help schools, local authorities and inspectors to judge what is working well and what needs to be improved. Following the inspection of each school, the Scottish Government gathers details of our evaluations to keep track of how well Scottish schools are doing.
