What is Small Talk?

Small Talk is an 8 week programme for parents and babies o-6 months delivered at various locations throughout Perth & Kinross. The programme looks at **bonding with your baby**, **early baby communication**, **the importance of reading and singing to your baby**, **baby milestones**, **sharing parenting experiences with other parents**, receiving a Treasure Pouch and visits from the library, speech therapist and dentist.

Treasure Pouches: the idea for Treasure Pouches came from Treasure Baskets which are used in nurseries and have been developed as a portable activity for parents and babies; they are light and can easily fit into a changing bag or pram.

What happens at a Small Talk group?

Small Talk programme

Over 8 weeks we will be looking at:

1st week: Welcome and introduction to Treasure Pouches

2nd week: The Connected Baby DVD

3rd week: Speech Therapist visit

4th week: Librarian information visit

5th week: Dental Smile Nurse visit

6th week: Weaning session

7th week: Helping babies learn & making choices: Play at home session

8th week: Moving on, foot painting & Evaluation

The Treasure Pouches will be used during the sessions and each session will end with a Rhymetime



Who can attend a **Small Talk** group?

Small Talk welcomes families with babies from birth to six months.

Where does Small Talk happen?

Small Talk groups can be found in a variety of settings such as in a community campus, community centre or health centre.
