Working with 0–4 year old children and their families at City of Perth Early Childhood Centre

Family Support Work offers support to children and families at nursery

This could include supporting parents to become:

- more involved in their children's learning and development
- strengthen family relationships
- cope with day to day situations
- improve the child's behaviour.

The Family Support Worker can help by:

- Providing a link between home and nursery
- Offering support for parenting
- Offering parenting programmes including Incredible Years (Parenting programme for parents with 3 year old children)
- Providing support to individual children and their families/carer's
- Working with families at home
- Working with other support agencies
- Working with groups of parents/carer's and children in nursery, schools and the community
- Offering parents and carers the opportunity to network and meet others

- Organising Parent and Child activities
- Helping with Family Clubs and holiday activities
- Offering Transition support
- Supporting appointments and meetings
- Signposting to other helpful relevant services



When would you contact the Family Support Worker?

There are many issues that might affect how children learn, grow and develop and how they cope in nursery, at home and in other areas of their lives.

If you have any concerns about your child a chat with the Family Support Worker may help.

How do you contact the Family Support Worker?

Speak with nursery staff or other service worker. You don't have to explain what it's about if you don't want to. If you would like support they will ask the Family Support Worker to contact you.

What will happen after that?

The Family Support Worker will contact you to arrange a meeting. The meeting will identify the type of support you think is most suitable.

The Family Support Worker will plan and work with you in achieving positive change.
