

UK Parliamentary Election 8 June 2017
Notice of Election
Ochil and South Perthshire Constituency

I, the Returning Officer for the above constituency, give notice that an election is to be held for a Member to serve in the Parliament of the United Kingdom for the said constituency.

If the election is contested the poll will be held on **Thursday 8 June 2017 between 7am and 10pm.**

Standing for election - Nominations

Nomination papers may be delivered by the candidate, his/her proposer, seconder or election agent (where previously arranged) to the Returning Officer, to the following place and at the following dates and times:

Place to collect and deliver nomination papers	Returning Officer, Election Office, Clackmannanshire Council, Kilncraigs, Greenside Street, Alloa, FK10 1EB
First collection/delivery permitted	10am, Monday 8 May 2017
Collection/delivery permitted	Between 10am and 4pm on any working day until the deadline given below
Deadline for delivery of nomination papers	4pm on Thursday 11 May 2017

Nomination papers may be obtained at the places and times mentioned above. The Returning Officer will, at the request of any elector, prepare for signature a nomination paper.

A person shall not be validly nominated as a candidate unless the sum of £500 is deposited by that person, or on that person's behalf, with the Returning Officer at the place and during the time for delivery of nomination papers. The deposit may be paid only (a) by legal tender; (b) by banker's draft (banks operating in the UK only); (c) by debit or credit card.

Applications to be included on the register of electors or for postal or proxy votes **must** reach the appropriate Electoral Registration Officer:
