1. Why is this information being processed?

2. Who is processing this information?

3. Why is it lawful for the Council to process this information?

The Council is permitted to process your personal data in this way because it is necessary for us to do so in order to provide a service that's in the public interest. The Local Government in Scotland Act 2003 gives local authorities the power to do anything which they consider is likely to improve its area and persons within that area; the service provided by Welfare Rights falls within the scope of this Power to Advance Well-Being 4. Will any sensitive personal information (Special Category Data or information about criminal convictions etc.) be processed?

If so, why is it lawful for the Council to process this information?

Some of the personal information that the Council processes when assessing and providing advice and representation – such as information about medical conditions - is more sensitive, and is known as Special Category Data. When an organization is processing Special Category Data it has to provide details of why it's lawful for us to do so. In the case of benefits advice and representation the Council is allowed to process this information under the terms of Article 9(2)(g) of the UK General Data Protection Regulation which permits the processing of information which is necessary for reasons of substantial public interest, with reference to Section (1) (1) of Schedule 1 of the Data Protection Act 2018

5. Will this information be shared?

Your personal information will be shared with third parties acting in your interests and with auditing bodies. It will not be disclosed further unless it is necessary for us to do so in order to verify its accuracy, prevent or detect crime, protect public funds or where required by law.

6. How long will this information be kept for?

Personal information held on Perth and Kinross Council systems in relation to Welfare Rights will be kept for 5 years. After this it will be deleted.
