Council Tax Application for Student Exemption or Discount



EXPLANATORY NOTE

To qualify as a student, for Council Tax purposes, you must either be:

- > someone undertaking a specified course at a college or university in the UK or other EU state for 21 hours or more per week for at least 24 weeks; or
- > someone under 20 studying for a qualification up to A Level, Higher, SHNC, NVQ/SVQ level 3 or equivalent via a course or courses for at least 12 hours a week for at least 3 months; please note that the course may not be taken as a result of your employment, may not be a correspondence course and may not be an evening class; or
- a foreign language assistant; or
- ➤ a student nurse studying an academic course at university or college which would (if successfully completed) lead to registration on any of Parts 1 to 8, 10 and 12 to 15 of the Register maintained under section 7 of the Nurses, Midwifes and Health Vistors Act 1997 as a **first inclusion** on that register

A property is exempt from Council Tax where all adult residents of the household are students, or a combination of students, local authority care leavers, recent school leavers or those affected by a severe mental impairment. Students are also disregarded from the calculation of the number of adult residents of a household for Council Tax discount purposes.

To apply for a Council Tax Discount or Exemption, this form must be completed and submitted along with evidence of your attendance on the states course
