COMMON GOOD FUNDS



Grants for group or individual initiatives which provide community benefit for the people who live in the Aberfeldy, Abernethy, Alyth, Auchterarder, Blairgowrie, Crieff, Kinross or Perth common good areas. Applications are accepted all year round.

COMMUNITY INVESTMENT FUND

Grants, managed by Local Action Partnerships, for community-led initiatives. The minimum grant is £3,000 and the maximum is £50,000. Grants are non-recurring, so funded projects must be time-limited, or able to show they are sustainable long-term through other funding routes.



PARTICIPATORY BUDGETING



Grants for initiatives which reduce inequalities. The minimum grant is £250 and the maximum is £3,000. Funding is allocated by residents voting on which initiatives they want to fund in their area. The grants are managed (and criteria is led) by Local Action Partnerships. Applications are typically accepted once a year.

COMMUNITY ENVIRONMENT CHALLENGE FUND

Grants for constituted community groups for environmental projects. The minimum grant is £2,500 and the maximum is £10,000. 50% match funding must be secured by the community group. Grants are available all year round.

Grants for sports clubs and individual athlete development. The maximum grant for clubs is £400 and the maximum grant for individuals is £200. Applications are accepted all year round.
