15 Minutes Free

Perth is the first city to recognise the 'click and collect' culture and has now introduced a 15 minute free parking policy. This only applies to Council-run car parks and on-street parking spaces. A valid ticket must be displayed and can be acquired free of charge.

*South Inch Car Park and Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park are now operated by a barrier 'pay on foot' system. To take advantage of the 15 minutes free, simply present your ticket at the exit terminal and exit the car park.

Please do not present your ticket at a pay station as this may charge you for an hour's parking.

Parking for Blue Badge Holders

Blue Badge holders are permitted to park in any Council-controlled pay and display bays on or off-street free of charge. Please refer to the Blue Badge leaflet for further information.



Season Tickets

Season Tickets are available in all our long stay car parks.

Coach Parking

There are designated coach drop-off/pick-up bays in Bridge Lane, George Street, Glover Street (Leisure Pool), South Street and Tay Street. There is parking for coaches in the South Inch Car Park.



Motorbike Parking

Free parking spaces designated by the letters M/C written on the road beside them are provided at various points throughout the city centre for use by bikers.

Park & Ride in Perth City

There are two Park & Ride sites operating in Perth, which provide convenient parking adjacent to the departure points for both buses to Perth City Centre and express coaches serving other Scottish cities.

Other Car Parks

Perth Parking Guide

15 Minutes FREE Car Parking*



*A free 15 minute ticket is now available for on-street parking and Council-owned car parks. Ticket must be displayed.

Parking in Perth City

Parking in Perth City is divided up into three zones.

Zone 1

Zone 1 encompasses all Council on and off-street parking bordered by Mill Street, South Methven Street, Canal Street and Tay Street (north of Queen's Bridge).

Parking is limited to 1 hour at a flat rate of £1.20.

Parking for up to 4 hours at a flat rate of £1.20 per hour is available at the Scott Street Car Park. All day parking is available at the Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park at a flat rate of £1.20 per hour for the first 4 hours, then up to 6 hours at £7.30 and up to 10 hours at £9.70. Season Tickets are available for Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park.

Zone 2

Zone 2 is bordered by Tay Street (south of Queen's Bridge), Marshall Place, Caledonian Road, Atholl Street and includes the Back Wynd Car Park in Bridgend.

Parking is for a maximum of 4 hours at a flat rate of £1.20 per hour.

Zone 3

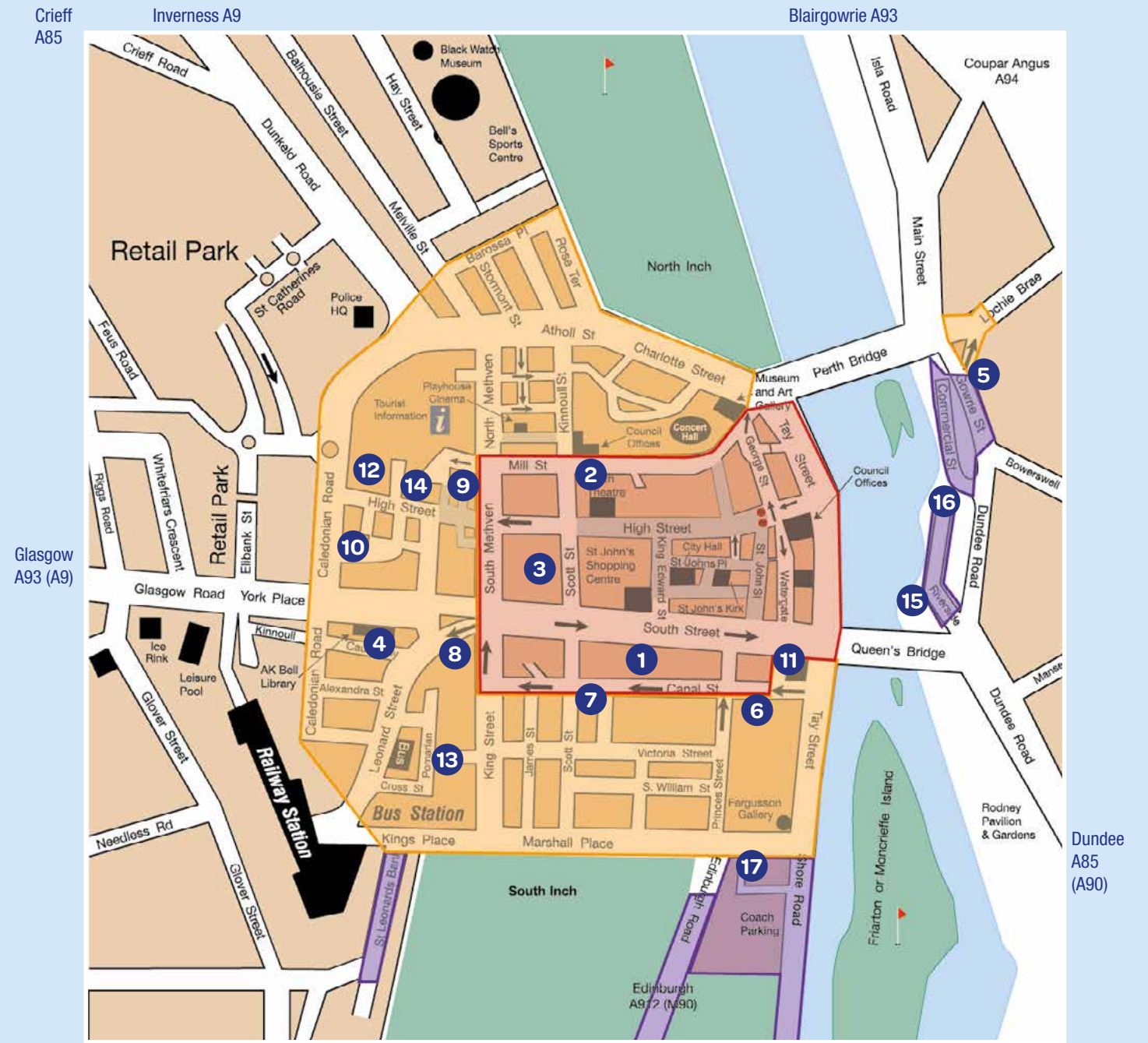
Zone 3 encompasses the South Inch Car Park and the on-street parking on Shore Road, Edinburgh Road, St Leonard's Bank, the east bank of the Tay with the Norie-Miller and Riverside Turning Head car parks.

Full-day parking is offered at:

Up to 1 Hour - £0.70	Up to 4 Hours - £2.40
Up to 2 Hours - £1.20	Up to 6 Hours - £3.60
Up to 3 Hours - £1.90	Up to 10 Hours - £4.80
