RingGo cashless parking will make it easier, simpler and more convenient for motorists to pay for parking. For full details on the scheme, please go to:







15 Minutes Free

Perth is the first city to recognise the 'click and collect' culture and has now introduced a 15 minute free parking policy.

This only applies to Council-run car parks and on-street parking spaces. A valid ticket must be displayed and can be acquired free of charge at the ticket machine*, except for the car parks below.

South Inch Car Park and Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park. These are operated by a barrier 'pay on foot' system. To take advantage of the free 15 minutes, simply present your ticket at the exit terminal and exit the car park. Please do not present your ticket at a pay station as this may charge you for an hour's parking.

*Thimblerow Car Park is pay by RingGo only, so as a 15 minute ticket cannot be acquired, a Parking Attendant will simply allow for a 15 minute grace period at the start of your parking session.

In all cases of the free 15 minute offer, no grace period applies upon the expiry of this.

Parking for Blue Badge Holders

Blue Badge holders are permitted to park in any Council-controlled pay and display bays on or off-street free of charge. Please refer to the Blue Badge leaflet for further information.

Season Tickets (Weekly, Monthly, 6 Monthly and Annually)

Season Tickets, which offer a significant saving over paying at the ticket issuing machines or per parking session, are available to purchase on RingGo for the following parking areas:

Gowrie Street

Riverside

Riverside Turning Head Car Park

Norrie Miller Car Park

Edinburgh Road

Victoria Street Car Park

Thimblerow Car Park*

With the exception of Thimblerow Car Park, all Season Tickets are "Zone Rovers" which mean they are interchangeable between other Season Ticket locations in Perth.

Season Tickets are also available to purchase from the paystations at the pay-on-foot car parks at South Inch and Canal Street Multi-Storey.

Motorbike Parking

Motorcycle Parking is free in any on or off street council Pay & Display bay in the city. Dedicated Motorcycle spaces are located in Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park and at Scott Street close to High Street Junction.

Park & Ride in Perth City

There are two Park & Ride sites operating in Perth, which provide convenient parking adjacent to the departure points for both buses to Perth City Centre and express coaches serving other Scottish cities.

Parking in Perth City

Parking in Perth City is divided up into three zones.

Zone 1

Zone 1 encompasses all Council on and off-street parking bordered by Mill Street, South Methven Street, Canal Street and Tay Street (north of Queen's Bridge).

Parking is limited to 1 hour at a flat rate of £1.30.

Parking for up to 4 hours at a flat rate of £1.30 per hour is available at the Scott Street Car Park. All day parking is available at the Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park at a flatrate of £1.30 per hour for the first 2 hours, then up to 3 hours at £4.00, 4 hours at £5.30, 6 hours at £8.00 and up to 10 hours at £10.70. Season Tickets are available for Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park.

Zone 2

Zone 2 is bordered by Tay Street (south of Queen's Bridge), Marshall Place, Caledonian Road, Atholl Street and includes the Back Wynd Car Park in Bridgend.

Parking is for a maximum of 4 hours at a flat rate of £1.30 per hour.

Zone 3

Zone 3 encompasses the South Inch Car Park and the on-street parking on Shore Road, Edinburgh Road, St Leonard's Bank, the east bank of the Tay with the Norie-Miller and Riverside Turning Head car parks.

Full-day parking is offered at:

Up to 1 Hour - £0.80	Up to 4 Hours - £2.60
