	STEP 2 – CONTEXT AND DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN
Context of the Plan:	The Supplementary Guidance will support policy 59 of the Proposed Local Development Plan. Once the LDP is adopted, the guidance will be adopted and used in the determination of planning applications in the Local Development Plan area. It will be used in conjunction with existing Scottish Government guidance (Planning Circular 2/2003); Civil Aviation Guidance (CAP 793); and industry guidelines from British Gliding Association and the General Aviation Awareness
	Council.
Description of the Plan:	The purpose of Airfield Safeguarding is to protect the airspace over and around the airfields in Perth and Kinross from the effects of possible adverse developments that may affect safe operation by controlling the use of land. This supplementary guidance will set out the circumstances under which consultation with airfield operators is required prior to determination of nearby planning applications. It will be limited spatially to the Local Development Plan area. Its temporal scope will be the same as the Local Development Plan to which it is connected (expected to be adopted in 2019 for five years). The adopted LDP already has a policy and supplementary guidance on Airfield Safeguarding.
What are the key components of the plan?	The supplementary guidance will identify airfields that could be affected by potential development in the Local Development Plan area, and will set out an area around each airfield within which planning applications that may impact on airfield operations will be referred to the airfield operator for consultation. The
	supplementary guidance will also highlight examples of the types of development that may be prejudicial to airfield operations. It is expected to focus on guiding the reader to existing guidelines and advice.
Have any of the components of the plan been considered in previous SEA work?	The LDP policy under which this supplementary guidance is to be prepared has been considered as part of the SEA of the LDP. The SEA is currently under way as part of the LDP review. The Proposed LDP contains an airfield safeguarding policy that sets out that airfield safeguarding will be taken into consideration when determining planning applications.
In terms of your response to Boxes 7 and 8 above, set out those components of the plan that are likely to require screening:	As the proposed Supplementary Guidance on Airfield Safeguarding will not introduce new material not already covered to an appropriate level in earlier SEA work, it will not generate any specific environmental effects of its own.
