

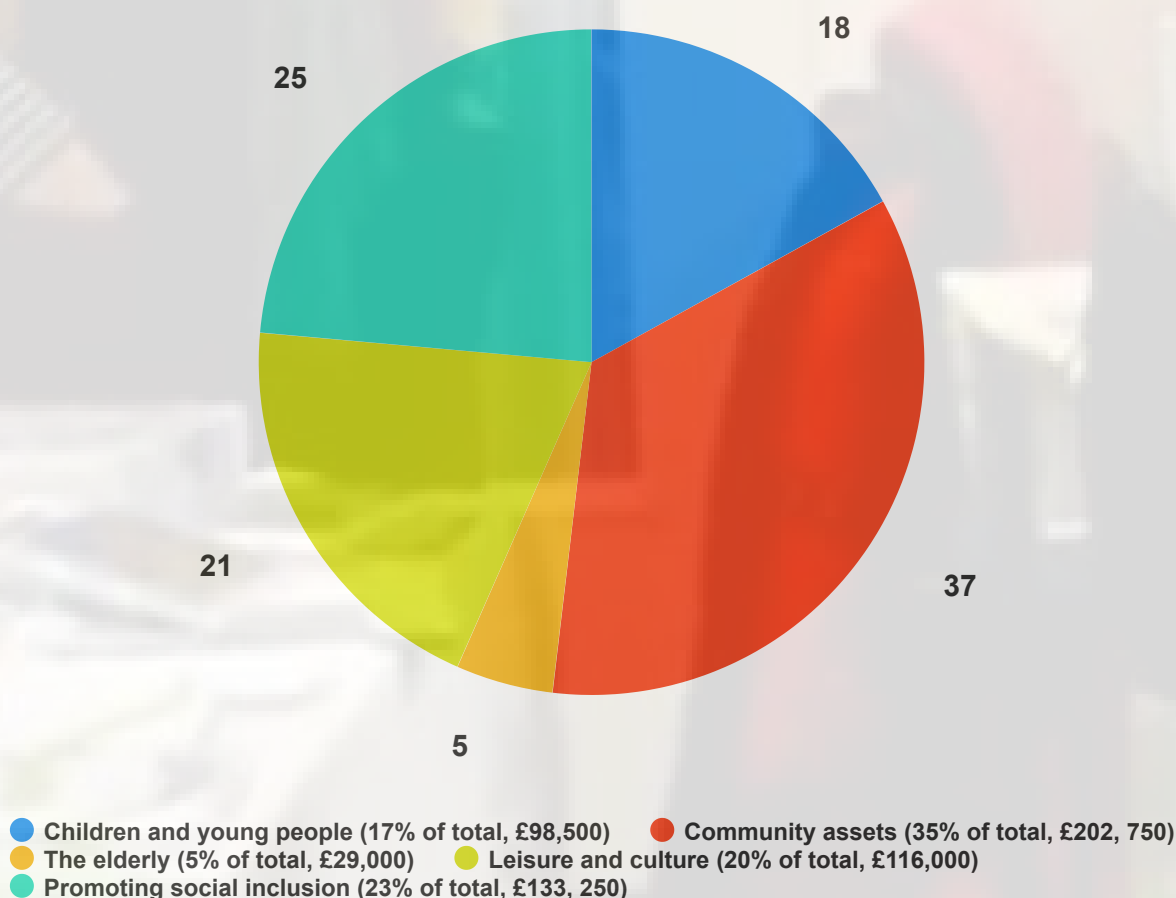
# Community Investment Fund (2018/19)

The Community Investment Fund (CIF) was launched by the Council in 2018 to provide £1.2m over two years to community projects that are aimed at tackling inequalities across Perth and Kinross.

Each of the 12 Council ward areas had £50,000 of funding allocated to it, and applications for between £3,000 and £50,000 could be submitted by community groups and organisations.

The first round of CIF saw 149 applications received, covering all aspects of community life. Of these, 105 were recommended by local ward panels for funding, as outlined below:

Round 2 of the Community Investment Fund will open in late Spring 2019, again offering funding for community-led projects that tackle inequalities and improve outcomes for residents in local communities.
