



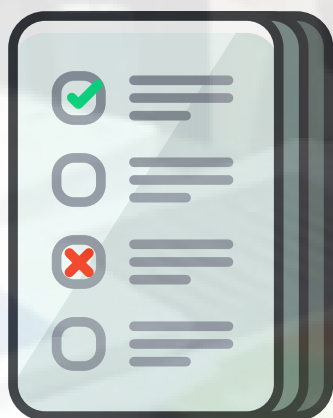

# Community Asset Transfers



The Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015 gives community groups the right to request to take on the ownership, management or use of an asset (land or buildings) owned by public authorities, including the Council.

**Successful\*** Community Asset Transfers can bring significant benefits to the applying group, the Council and the community as a whole.



Any group looking to make a Community Asset Transfer must check if they have an eligible legal structure before submitting an application.
