## Are Your Electrical Items Too Good To Throw Away?



If your electrical items, white goods and electronic equipment are not fit for reuse, please **recycle them** at PKC Recycling Centres.

**Remove batteries** from electrical and electronic equipment where possible and dispose of them in the battery recycling container at PKC Recycling Centres. **Batteries in a sealed unit should be left intact and not broken.** 

Batteries left in electrical and electronic equipment when they are recycled are a significant **fire risk.** So please check items such as cameras, mobile phones, laptops, medical equipment and power tools to ensure the batteries are removed before recycling them.
