2. Who is processing this information?

3. Why is it lawful for the Council to process this information?

The Council is permitted to process your personal data in this way because it is in the public interest for us to provide alternative ways for members of the public to contact us.

Formally, the processing of personal data provided to us for this purpose satisfies Article 6(1)(e) of the General Data Protection Regulation - Processing shall be lawful...to the extent that processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller

4. Will any sensitive personal information (Special Category Data or information about criminal convictions etc.) be processed?

Although this platform is not intended to be used for processing personal information, people using it may enter details of e.g. medical conditions.

If so, why is it lawful for the Council to process this information?

In this case, the Council is allowed to process this information under the terms of Article 9(2)(g) of the GDPR; this permits the processing of information when it's necessary to do so for reasons of substantial public interest.

Schedule 1, Part 2 Section 6(2)(a) of the Data Protection Act 2018 says that there is a public interest in the Council processing Special Category Data when it is done in "the exercise of a function conferred on a person by an enactment or rule of law". The relevant law in this case is the Local Government in Scotland Act 2003, which gives local authorities the power to do anything which they consider is likely to improve its area and persons within that area; the provision of alternative ways to contact the Council falls within the scope of this power to advance wellbeing.

5. Will this information be shared?

Your personal information will not be disclosed to third parties unless it's necessary for us to do so in order to verify its accuracy, prevent or detect crime, protect public funds or where required by law. The Council may check information provided by you, or information about you provided by a third party, with other information held by us.

6. How long will this information be kept for?

Personal information held on Perth and Kinross Council systems in relation to emails and webchats for 6 months. After this they will be deleted.

7. Personal Information Rights

Individuals have rights in relation to the information the Council holds about them, including the right to request a copy of their information.
