Kinross-shire Volunteer Group and Rural Outreach Scheme

- Established 37 years ago in 1983
- Operate a befriending and driving service for residents of Kinross-shire and Glenfarg
- A vital service for the elderly, disabled and vulnerable members of the community
- Enabling clients to attend health centre, hospital, dental appointments
- Increasing social trips to help address social isolation
- Destinations include, LLHC, PRI, Ninewells, Victoria Hospital, Forth Valley and even as far as Golden Jubilee Hospital in Dalmuir

- Part-time paid co-ordinator
- Currently 35 volunteer drivers
- Management committee consisting of 7 volunteers
- Constitution drawn up and approved to ensure good governance
- Accounts professionally examined and approved annually
- Volunteers undergo initial training and KVG/ROS hold annual training updates
- Recently awarded 'Volunteer Friendly Award' from PKAVS
- Recognised by Age Scotland for the delivery of our service in the community

- Service is open to all in the community
- Growing demand with currently an excess of 300 clients
- On average we undertake 160 round trips per month
- In 2019 we did some 2400 journeys covering approx. 40,000 miles
- Including the Management Committee that totals some 3010 volunteer hours

- Calls from clients are received and logged by our co-ordinator
- A driver is allocated and contacted to confirm availability
- Client is advised of who the volunteer is and when they will be picked up
- Driver reinforces this message by direct contact the day before the appointment
- Client reimburses the volunteer expenses .. Set rate for each destination
- Co-ordinator submits monthly stats to PKC
