**How much does it cost?**

Up to 5hrs £19.00

Up to 7hrs £21.25

7hrs+ £23.50

There is also a Registration Fee of £13.00 for a single child and £20.00 for two or more children in the same family. This fee enables you to access any Wrap around Care and Kids Club until 1 July 2021.

**Does my Child need to bring anything?**

Play can be a messy business, we advise all children to wear clothes suitable for messy play and where possible to bring a change of clothes. Good waterproof outdoor clothing is advisable and in case of good weather you should provide your child with sun cream. Further details are available from the service.

**Lunches**

Children should bring a packed lunch with them. Please note we cannot heat any foods or prepare your child's lunch, lunches must be in their own lunch box with a cold pack inside. Healthy snacks will be provided mid-morning and mid-afternoon and your child will have access to milk and water throughout the session. Please discuss any dietary requirements with the Wraparound Care Staff.
