- A responsible person who may be the Club Covid officer should fill out the Pitch Booking Application Form and shall be deemed to be the Hirer and shall be responsible for compliance with all rules, regulations or requirements made or laid down by the Council or governing bodies in respect of the use of the grounds and premises and shall be deemed to be the responsible person nominated to be in charge while the game is being held.
- Teams are responsible for line-marking the pitch throughout the season. PKC will carry out the initial Mark and Measure, but no additional lining can be guaranteed even as a paid service.
- The home team will be responsible for ensuring that all litter resulting from matches is collected and disposed of safely – Council Officers will monitor this.
- Teams should assess pitch conditions and decide if the pitch is playable. Choosing not to play when the ground is too wet is in the team's best interest if they wish to continue playing there for a full season.
- Pitches cannot be sub-let without prior permission of the Council.
